


Who are we?

We now offer free day care for the children of our adult volunteers.

History

Helping Hands Mission Camp began in 2005 to help the citizens of Gloucester County who are "falling through the cracks", meaning that there is much more need than there is help for those who cannot afford or who are physically unable to repair their homes or build wheelchair ramps.

Our goals also include helping youth to realize their potential by showing them what they are capable of when they work together to help their neighbors and teaching them leadership skills. We provide an opportunity for different churches and denominations to come together and accomplish necessary community service projects. Camp is also an opportunity for faith-building & creating a stronger bond with Jesus Christ.

Helping Hands is a faith community effort and is overseen by a diverse board of local church members who plan all year for camp, which is held one week in July, Sunday through Friday.
