## **Rules for Helping Hands Mission Camp 2014**

The following rules are meant to keep us all safe and to focus our minds on Jesus during the week of camp:

- Please remember -- this building is a house of worship and should be treated with the utmost respect for the building and property in and around it.
- There will be no water fights, or any other pranks inside the building
- Stay out of dorms that are not yours. No girls on the boys' halls, no boys on girls' halls. Opposite sexes may visit in the designated areas.
- PDAs (public displays of affection) between males and females should be appropriate to a CHURCH retreat: no lap sitting, hugging, kissing, etc.
- Please do not bring shirts that show your midriff, spaghetti strap shirts, are low cut or shirts with inappropriate content on them.
- Shorts or skirts must be longer than longest finger when arms are down at your side. Pants should not be sagging or showing underwear.
- SWIMSUITS: One piece swimsuits ONLY. No tankinis, bikinis, etc. You will not be able to go swimming if you are not properly dressed.
- Weapons, drugs, alcohol and tobacco are prohibited.
- No one can leave the building after Lights Out. If you have an emergency talk to your dorm monitor.
- No running, throwing things or horseplay in the building. Be careful of windows and glass doors.
- Please do not sit on sanctuary chairs until you have cleaned up from the worksite.
- Please reserve the sanctuary for prayer, preparation for worship and personal time with God during free times.
- Kitchen is off limits to campers, unless you are working there. Do not use it as a short cut.
- If you have an emergency and need to leave camp for any reason, you must let <u>Terry Stacey</u> know.
- SAFETY ON WORK SITES IS TOP PRIORITY. NO HORSEPLAY OR WASTING OF SUPPLIES WILL BE TOLERATED. DO NOT LEAVE YOUR WORKSITE WITHOUT PERMISSION OF SITE LEADER, SITE ASSISTANT AND TEAM MANAGER.

- Power tools may not be used by campers under 18 without direct adult supervision.
- Bring appropriate clothing for the worksite: Pants no shorter than your knee, t-shirt and shoes with closed toe. No flip flops on worksite. Loose fitting cotton work pants are best for staying cooler and keeping dirt off your legs.
- NO Electronic Devices allowed at camp. This includes (but not limited to) cell phones, iPods, iPads, video games or systems, MP3 players, etc.
- Meal Time: Please find a seat until prayers are said. If a camper volunteers to pray over the meal, they will be allowed to get their food when the adults do. After that teams will be called to get in line to get their meals.
- **Clean Up Duty:** Teams will take turns cleaning up the dining room after meals.

Before we go home:

- $\blacksquare$  The church has to be cleaned. More about that at camp.
- Return all coolers and tools to the church.
